Vincent Dubois, sociologist and political scientist, was born in 1966. As a permanent position, he is Professor at the University of Strasbourg, France (Institute for Political Studies) where he runs the master program in political science. He belongs to the SAGE research unit and is an associate member of the Centre for European Sociology and Political Science in Paris. He is a former editor of the scientific journal *Sociétés contemporaines* (Presses de Sciences Po, Paris), and currently a member of the associate editorial board of the *Actes de la recherche en sciences sociales*, of the *International Journal of Cultural Policy* and of *Critical Policy Studies*. A former member of the Institut Universitaire de France (2007-2012), he was a Florence Gould member at the Institute for advanced study in Princeton NJ, USA, school of social science (2012-13) and a fellow at the Strasbourg Institute for Advanced Study (2014-2016).
